# WHERE TO USE

**Mapefloor Cleaner ED** is suitable in all those cases where a strong detergent is required on surfaces which are not subject to damage by water.

**Mapefloor Cleaner ED** has been specially developed for cleaning resin floors, such as the **Mapefloor System**, and leaves a clean, shiny finish on the floor surface.

#### Some application examples

- Cleaning treatment for resin floors made using the **Mapefloor System** internal environment for civil, public and industrial use.
- Cleaning treatment for protective films on decorative floors made using **Ultratop**, including those mixed with natural aggregates and in environments for civil use such as showrooms, shops and apartments.

#### **TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS**

Mapefloor Cleaner ED is a concentrated water-soluble product made of a special mixture of surfactant, low-foaming components, for cleaning greasy stains from washable surfaces and floors subject to heavy traffic. The action of the surfactant components is completed by the solvent and deodorising action of the terpinolene contained in the product.

The product contains minimun primary biodegradability of 90% and ultimate aerobic biodegradability complying with Reg. (EC) n. 648/2004.

#### **HOW TO USE**

The product may be used by hand or with mechanical cleaning means.

Use **Mapefloor Cleaner ED** at a concentration from 1 to 3% (100-300 g in 10 litres of water). Increase the concentration according to requirements on porous or heavily soiled surfaces.

#### **PACKAGING**

Mapefloor Cleaner ED is available in 10 kg cans.

Non-ionic, anionic surfactants, soap, phosphates (as P): conc. < 5%



### **STORAGE**

**Mapefloor Cleaner ED** can be stored for 24 months in its original packaging at a temperature between +10°C and +30°C. Protect from frost.
